Youth Action has 3 components: School programs, Friday night drop-ins and Saturday Dances. On average staff are scheduled to work 6 - 10 hours per week.

### Responsibilities:

- To lead recreational programs for youth ages 10-15 Monday-Thursday at local schools. Staff shifts may begin as early as 5pm.
- To supervise and lead recreational activities during Friday night drop-in programs.
- To host and supervise Saturday dances – minimum 2x per month.
- To build relationships with youth and be a positive role model.
